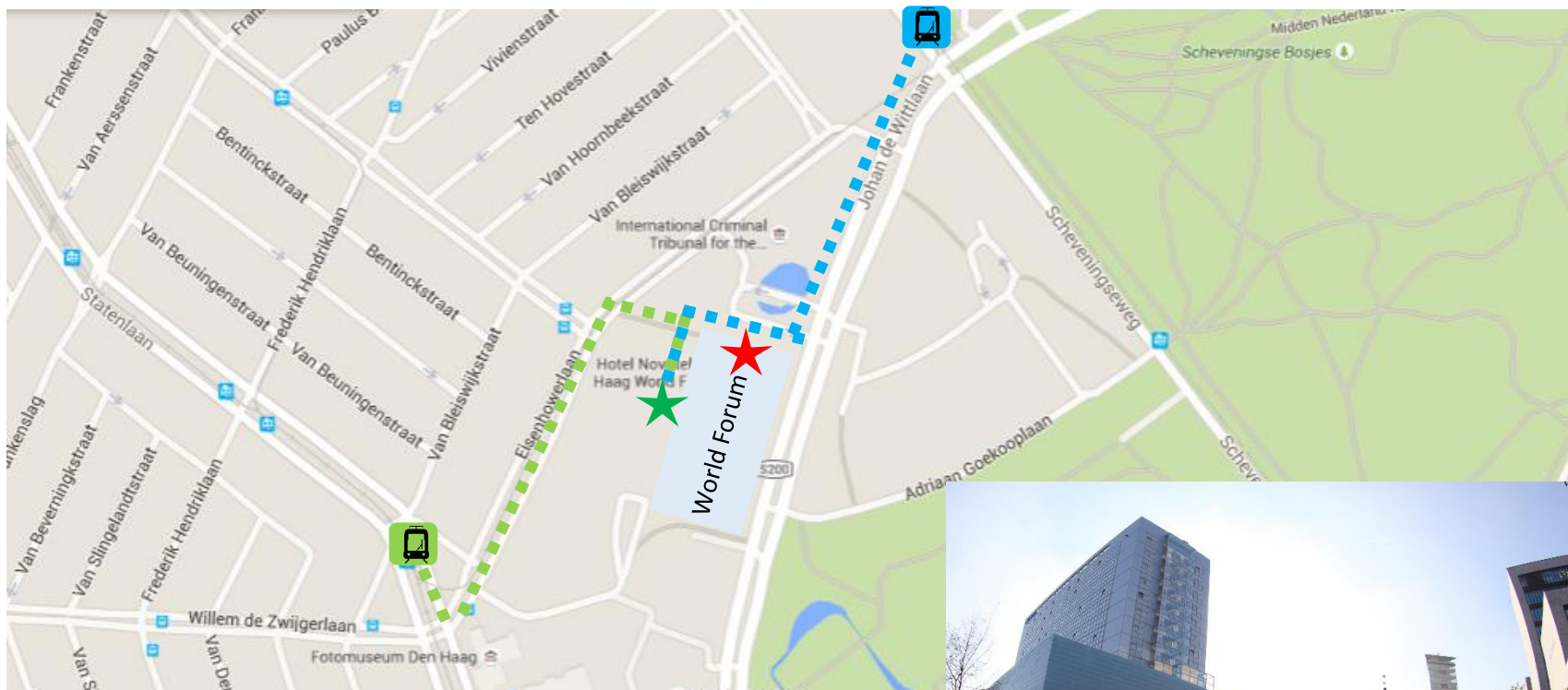


ACCESS AND ENTRANCE INFORMATION FOR WEF

DIRECTIONS

Public transport

From The Hague Central Station or The Hague Holland Spoor you can reach the World Forum with:

- Tram 1 (get off at stop World Forum, about 5 minutes walk).
- Tram 16 (get off at stop Statenplein, about 5 minutes walk).

By car

From Utrecht/Amsterdam

From Utrecht/Amsterdam Take the A12 towards The Hague. When the A12 becomes Utrechtsebaan, continue until the road ends. At the traffic lights, turn left onto the Zuid Hollandlaan. When the road ends, turn right at the traffic lights onto Koningskade. Koningskade turns into Raamweg. Continue under the viaduct, then follow the curve in the road to the right onto the Hubertus Viaduct. This puts you onto Prof. B.M. Teldersweg, which then turns into Johan de Wittlaan. Follow signs to the World Forum and park in the underground parking garage.

From Amsterdam/Leiden

Take the A44 from Amsterdam and follow the signs to The Hague/N44. As soon as you pass Wassenaar, take the exit for The Hague/Scheveningen N14. Follow this road into the Hubertus Tunnel. Emerging from the tunnel, continue straight on to the Hubertus Viaduct. This puts you onto Prof. B.M. Teldersweg, which then turns into Johan de Wittlaan. Follow signs to the World Forum and park in the underground parking garage.

From Rotterdam

From the A13, at the Ypenburg interchange follow the signs for Amsterdam/A4. At Prins Clausplein, follow the signs for The Hague/Voorburg. Cross the viaduct and follow the signs for The Hague. This puts you onto Utrechtsebaan. From here, follow the directions given above.

Parking

The World Forum has an underground parking. Parking tickets can be purchased at the payment machines in the parking.
